Inspired by a news report it is a hard hitting tale that brings forth the severe bias on basis on caste still prevalent in rural India. The project was presented at the **Film Bazaar Co-Production Market** this year and was awarded the **Incredible India Award** (INR 10 Lakhs) by the **Ministry of Tourism.**

Chauranga will be produced by **Anticlock Films** an independent production company run by director-producer Onir and actor-producer Sanjay Suri. Their line up of films includes *My Brother Nikhil* a significant film that brought the issue of homosexuality and HIV (AIDS) to the forefront, *I am, Bas Ek Pal,* and *Sorry Bhai*. Bikas Mishra the director of *Chauranga is the editor of the online* portal for Indian Films, Film Festivals and World Cinema.

The Göteborg International Film Festival will be held from January 26 to February 6, 2012.
